BRIEF RESUMES OF THE JUDGES

Karen Iversen

Karen is from Lecanto, Florida has been a breed association judge since 1988 receiving her AMHA card in 1990. She is an approved judge for American Miniature Horse Association (senior), Pinto Horse Association, American Shetland Pony Club., and many donkey and mule associations. Her judging credits include the AMHA World Show (2005), Ponys of American International Show (2004), American Shetland Pony Congress, North American Saddle Mule Association International World Show, numerous large state fairs and major stock shows in the US, and recently shows in the Netherlands and Canada. she judges 60-80 shows a year. Judge Iversen and her farrier husband, Richard, own and operate the Diamond K Ranch in Lecanto where they offer lessons, training and showing of quarter horses.

Sonny Williams

Sonny has been judging horses for over 20 years. Everything from Miniature horses to Draft horses.

Currently he holds judge's cards with American Miniature Horse Registry (AMHR), American Miniature Horse Association (AMHA), American Draft and Mule Association (ADMA), American Buckskin Registry Association (ABRA) and American Mustang Association (AMA). Over the years he has judged the following shows: National, Regional, County fairs and held multiple training clinics.

He started out showing Halter Horses, then progressed to performance, driving, and is currently breeding and training Thoroughbreds. In his spare time Sonny is a Teacher (of 6th, 7th and 8th grade) working for the US public school system.

Kim Seipp

Kim has had a passion for horses her whole life and has spent most of that time either physically involved with horses or learning about them. As a young child she was part of a Drill Team in Colorado called "the Westernaires" which has performed at many national events in the United States.

When her children were young she led the 4H Horse program that her children were involved in and spent many hours teaching Hippology and riding.

Her career with miniature horses began in the mid 90's when she purchased her first miniature. Since then she has been actively involved in both the AMHA and the AMHR in the United States.

Owning and breeding miniature horses have been very rewarding. She has owned, bred and trained several horses to National titles and Top Tens. She currently trains miniature horses professionally and has several National Championships and Top Ten's to her credit. In addition to her training center she has facilitated numerous clinics to encourage individuals to participate in showing horses and giving them the skills necessary to succeed.

She holds judging cards in both AMHA & AMHR as well as all divisions of the ASPC and the Colorado 4H. As a carded judge she has officiated many shows. She recently has been invited to judge the AMHR Miniature Nationals in September 2006.

Judging in New Zealand is an opportunity of a life time for Kim and she is thrilled at the prospect of being able to utilise her knowledge and skills at the New Zealand Nationals.

ERRORS & OMISSIONS

Should there be a conflict between this schedule and the NZMHA Show Rules or Constitution then this schedule shall not prevail. Please bring any such error or omission to the attention of the show organisers so that it can be rectified.

JUDGING SYSTEM

The NZMHA National Show will have 3 judges who will judge the classes and an accumulated points system will be utilised. Horses placed under each judge will receive the following points:

1 st Place – 8 points	3 rd Place – 6 points	5 th Place – 4 points	7 th Place – 2 points
2 nd Place – 7 points	4 th Place – 5 points	6 th Place – 3 points	8 th Place – 1 point

Points earned by each horse from all judges will be added together to give a total score. The call judge's placing will be used to break all ties. The official call judge for this show will be Karen Iversen.

REFUNDS

No refund will be given without a current veterinarian certificate. Only 70% of entry fees will be refunded. This certificate must be received by the show manager prior to the commencement of the first class of the show.

HOLDING AREA

IMPORTANT: Horses will be called into the arena to be presented for judging in order of back numbers. To ensure the smooth running of the show Competitors must be in the collection area within 3 minutes of the last Competitor of the previous class entering the show ring. The gate steward will exclude late Competitors from competition in that class. This includes Champions and Supremes. Horses from the class immediately preceding are excluded from this requirement. The gate steward must be informed if a halter break is required, or the gate will not be held.

MEASURING OF HORSES

Measuring will be available between 5:00pm and 5:30pm on Friday by PRIOR ARRANGEMENT ONLY. There will be a charge of **\$10.00 (GST Inc.) per Horse**. Please try and get your horses measured before this show - contact your NZMHA Regional Delegate.

GENERAL

BACKNUMBERS ARE TO BE WORN ON THE BACK

Once entered, no changes may be made to entries except under the following circumstances:

- horses entered as Category A and measured in excess of Height for Age for Category A **prior** to the judging of the first class on the first day of competition will be moved to the corresponding classes in Category B;
- where the horse entered for handler-related classes (best presented/showmanship/whip) is scratched from the Shows **prior** to the first class on the first day of competition another horse (already catalogued) may be substituted;
- horses/exhibitors entered in Novice classes who upgrade to Open prior to the Show will be moved to Open.

The organisers reserve the right to split/combine/cancel classes where entries warrant it

All horses including foals must have a current NZMHA height certificate in accordance with NZMHA Show Rules

NOTE: - Height Certificates must be NO OLDER THAN 45 days for Yearlings and Foals
