### **BRIEF RESUMES OF THE JUDGES**

#### **Ray Randall**

Ray is a 30-year horse industry veteran who has managed, announced, and been photographer at major North American shows and futurities. Ray has been a delegate for breed conventions and has served on national committees dealing with equine stress management, research and education, show secretaries and amateurs. He and his wife, Cheri, in 2000 were named one of the top 15 Arabian breeders in North America. Just recently, he retired from teaching middle school after 35 years on the job.

Ray has judged a number of AMHA recognised Miniature Horse Shows (38\*) including the AMHA National Show (last in 2005) and holds cards for Arabian , AHA, AMHA (1994) AMHR and ASPC

#### **Judith Warner**

Judy's family operated a successful Arabian breeding farm from 1969 to 1995; showed family owned and bred Arabian and Half Arabian horses to many regional wins. She has attended hunter clinics, National Reining Horse Association seminars as well as carriage driving seminars. She presently has one Half Arabian mare which she bred and showed throughout the 80's and which she now pleasure rides.

Judy has the US Arabian National Championships (3 times), Canadian National Championships (twice), Scottsdale Arabian H.S. (twice), Brazilian National Arabian Championships, Andalusian National Championships, Friesian Grand National Championships, AMHA National Championship (twice – last in 2003), AMHR National Championships, South African Arabian HS and numerous Regional Arabian Championships.

Judy has judged a number of AMHA recognised Miniature Horse Shows (44\*) and holds cards for Arabian (since 1977), Andalusian (2002), Friesian (2005), AMHA (1993), AMHR and ASPC (Classic and Modern Shetlands).

#### **Wayne Hipsley**

No stranger to the American Miniature Horse and its long history, Wayne G. Hipsley, brings to the show ring many years of experience judging and educating others to judge the American Miniature Horse. He first became involved with the breed in the 1989, when he exhibited Miniatures, and then eventually became involved with the education and licensing of AMHA judges. He served as the facilitator for the AMHA Judges Seminars for over 6 years, while also working with the re-structuring of the show rules and regulations. He has been a licensed AMHA judge of over 15 years. On two occasions he served as a consultant to the AMHA on the review of their management and operations procedures. In the last 9 years, he has worked on the international scene, taking judge's educational programs to Belgium, New Zealand, The Netherlands, and the United Kingdom. In conjunction with these educational programs he has written a handbook and guide for judging the American Miniature Horse. He was one of the speakers for the first international seminar and clinic sponsored by the AMHA held in 2003 at Brussels, Belgium. He enjoys judging the American Miniature Horse, and appreciates the qualities and advantages of Miniature Horse ownership. Currently, he is operating his equine consulting business, Hipsley & Associates, from Lexington, Kentucky, working with clients around the globe and judging horse shows.

***The New Zealand Miniature Horse Show* will be run in accordance with NZMHA's Official Show Rule Booklet 2006/2007 and will be conducted and judged in accordance therewith. Please read these rules carefully to make sure you are entitled and qualified to enter each class.**

Placings are to 5<sup>th</sup> place.

NZMHA RESERVES THE RIGHT TO CHANGE THE PROGRAMME OR RUNNING OF THIS SHOW IN ANY WAY WITHOUT FURTHER NOTICE.

ANY CHANGES TO THE PROGRAMME WILL BE POSTED ON THE DAY AT THE INFORMATION DESK.

### **JUDGING SYSTEM**

*The New Zealand Miniature Horse Show* will have 3 judges who will judge the classes and an accumulated points system will be utilised. Horses placed under each judge will receive the following points:

1 <sup>st</sup> Place – 8 points	3 <sup>rd</sup> Place – 6 points	5 <sup>th</sup> Place – 4 points	7 <sup>th</sup> Place – 2 points
2 <sup>nd</sup> Place – 7 points	4 <sup>th</sup> Place – 5 points	6 <sup>th</sup> Place – 3 points	8 <sup>th</sup> Place – 1 point

Points earned by each horse from all judges will be added together to give a total score. The call judge's placing will be used to break all ties. The official call judge for this show will be Judith Warner.

### **ENTRY AND REGISTRATION RULES**

*The New Zealand Miniature Horse Show* is open to any horse registered with NZMHA which is owned and shown by a current financial member of NZMHA. Note: For a non-NZMHA member to handle horses at the show they must be registered (Handler Registration) with NZMHA BEFORE the closing of entries for the show.

A copy of the horse's current NZMHA height certificate must be attached. Entry is deemed to be incomplete and may be refused if height certificates are not enclosed.

No refund will be given without a current veterinarian certificate. Only 70% of entry fees will be refunded. This certificate must be received by the show manager prior to the commencement of the first class of the show.

### **HOLDING AREA**

**IMPORTANT:** Horses will be called into the arena to be presented for judging in order of back numbers. To ensure the smooth running of the show Competitors must be in the collection area within 3 minutes of the last Competitor of the previous class entering the show ring. The gate steward will exclude late Competitors from competition in that class. This includes Champions and Supremes. Horses from the class immediately preceding are excluded from this requirement. The gate steward must be informed if a halter break is required, or the gate will not be held.

### **MEASURING OF HORSES**

Measuring will be available between 5:00pm and 5:30pm on Thursday by **PRIOR ARRANGEMENT ONLY**. There will be a charge of **\$20.00 (GST Inc.) per Horse**. Please try and get your horses measured before this show - contact your NZMHA Regional Delegate.

### **GENERAL**

#### **BACKNUMBERS ARE TO BE WORN ON THE BACK**

Once entered, no changes may be made to entries except under the following circumstances:

- horses entered as Category A and measured in excess of Height for Age for Category A **prior** to the judging of the first class on the first day of competition will be moved to the corresponding classes in Category B;
- where the horse entered for handler-related classes (best presented/showmanship/whip) is scratched from the Shows **prior** to the first class on the first day of competition another horse (already catalogued) may be substituted;
- horses/exhibitors entered in Novice classes who upgrade to Open prior to the Show will be moved to Open.

The organisers reserve the right to split/combine/cancel classes where entries warrant it

**All horses including foals must have a current NZMHA height certificate in accordance with NZMHA Show Rules**

**NOTE: - Height Certificates must be NO OLDER THAN 45 days for Yearlings and Foals**

### **STABLING**
