Dear Members

Welcome to the 2012 New Zealand Miniature Horse National Show Information Booklet and Schedule of Classes. We are all looking forward to coming back to Christchurch for our National Show.

We also look forward to welcoming the Miniature Horse Association of Australia (MHAA) Youth Team as once again they compete against the NZMHA Youth Team for the Trans Tasman Trophy.

Some of the special events from previous years National Shows are being held, including the Youth BBQ and also the Sweepstakes Classes which were held for the first time last year. Don't forget the Costume Classes which are free to enter.

For the first time the show will be run over 4 days which in itself is a challenge. As many of you will know the fabulous arena we use is used during the week for the RDA and we can only hold classes indoors during a weekend. We have made arrangements to have access to the arena on Thursday and Friday afternoons which means that classes will be held indoors from 5pm on those days and of course all Saturday and Sunday. New National Show Rules adopted at the 2011 Annual General Meeting has meant that to hold the 4 day show as required under the rules we must be outside for 2 of the 4 days whenever the National Show is in Christchurch.

*The New Zealand Miniature Horse National **Show** will be run in accordance with NZMHA's Official Show Rule Booklet 2011/2012 and will be conducted and judges in accordance therewith. Please read these rules carefully to make sure you are entitled and qualified to enter each class.*

Entry Forms

This year the entry forms are included in this booklet along with request forms for camping and stable bedding. The forms are at the back of this booklet so you will be able to remove them without disturbing the rest of the information.

Closing Date for Entries

This is Tuesday 6th March 2012.

Registration Upgrades

Please make sure you have all your upgrades and registrations up to date as no entries will be accepted with registrations "pending".

Stabling

We are fortunate in that there are plenty of stables available for hire and the cost per stable is the actual charge imposed on us by the Canterbury A & P Association.

The rates are:

\$50 per stable if staying more than 2 days and will include those arriving early from NI and out of town.

Stable – 1 night \$25

Stable – 2 plus nights \$50

The boxes come automatically with straw supplied but if you do not wish for straw you can order sawdust.

You will need to order and pay for your own sawdust.

Camping

Camping is permitted on the show grounds at \$30.00 per site but note there is no power available. Please make your bookings and payment direct to the grounds Caretaker, Dugald. If you do intend to camp on the grounds please indicate on the Information Sheet in this booklet and forward with your show entries. This is to advise us if showers are to be made available. If you do not advise us you are camping showers will not be available and you will need to make your own arrangements/payments.

Photographer

A photographer will be at the show and we are currently exploring the possibility of having the show videoed. The cost may prove to be too prohibitive but if we are able to go ahead we will make an announcement at the show.

Youth BBQ – Youth Auction

Once again we will hold our Youth BBQ and this will be a ticketed event. Tickets can be ordered at \$10.00 per person and prepaid with your entries. Further tickets may be purchased at the show.

The Youth Auction will follow the BBQ and all proceeds from the auction will be put toward the NZMHA Youth Team.

Measuring

It is a requirement of the National Show Rules that all foals and yearlings are to be height verified at the show.

All measuring will be by appointment only – this includes height verification for foals and yearlings. Contact Heather Lough to book your appointment.

Refer to *Measuring of Horses* in this booklet for further information.

Performance Cards

It will be mandatory for all those horses and handlers entering Novice classes to provide a copy of their performance cards **with their show entry**. Please make sure your horse's novice status is updated prior to the show as well as Handler cards. If you do not have a Handler card you may get one from your Regional Delegate or the Show Convenor.

The original card must be lodged with the Show Manager on the day of the Novice class entered **before** the class takes place. That is, for horses, its Height Certificate/Performance card and for handlers, the Handler Card. Failure to do so will mean that you will be refused entry to the class.

Trophy/Class Sponsorship

This continues again this year and a form is included in TT. Various levels of class and trophy sponsorship is available and this is a good way to have your stud or business promoted. Any queries please contact the Show Manager or Show Convenor.

JUDGING SYSTEM

Placings are to 5th place.

The New Zealand Miniature Horses National Show will have 3 judges who will judge the classes and an accumulated points system will be utilised. Horses placed under each judge will receive the following points:

1st Place – 8 points	3rd Place – 6 points	5th Place – 4 points	7th Place – 2 points
2nd Place – 7 points	4th Place – 5 points	6th Place – 3 points	8th Place – 1 point

Points earned by each horse from all judges will be added together to be the total score. The call judge's placing will be used to break all ties.

For performance classes that are judged on scores: Each judge will place the top eight horses in the order of their scores. The above points system will then be utilised to determine the placings. Top five placings (National Grand, Reserve National Grand, 3rd, 4th, and 5th) will then be determined based on the combination of placings in the classes and ordinary scores.

ALL ROUND AWARDS

The following points system will apply to:

- New Zealand National Grand Champion Performance Horse – Cat A and Cat B
- New Zealand National Champion Best All Round Horse – Cat A and Cat B
- New Zealand National Champion Best All Round Junior Youth
- New Zealand National Champion Best All Round Senior Youth

1 st place =	5 points
2 nd place =	4 points
3 rd place =	3 points
4 th place =	2 points
5 th place =	1 point

In the event of a tie the following count back will apply: most 1sts, followed by most 2nds etc down to 5th place.

SWEEPSTAKE CLASSES

Category A and Category B are separate classes. Open to any age or sex within that category. Classes will be judged using the normal halter workout of the day.

All entry fee sweepstakes money and sponsorship moneys will be paid out to the Top 10 horses in each category.

1st place	25%
2nd place	20%
3rd place	15%
4th place	10%
5th to 10th places	5%

ENTRY AND REGISTRATION RULES

The New Zealand Miniature Horse National Show is open to any horse registered with NZMHA which is owned and shown by a current financial member of NZMHA. Note: For a non-NZMHA member to handle horses at the show they must be registered (Handler Registration) with NZMHA BEFORE the closing of entries for the show.

Handlers - Minimum age to compete is 5 years of age.

A copy of the horse's current NZMHA height certificate and both sides of their registration certificate must be attached. Entry is deemed to be incomplete and may be refused if copies of these certificates are not enclosed.

Where applicable, copies of NZMHA leases must also be provided at time of entry.

REFUNDS

No refund will be given without a current veterinarian certificate. Only 70% of entry fees will be refunded. This certificate must be received by the show manager prior to the commencement of the first class of the show.

Stabling fees will be refunded in full if stables are reallocated by show management.

MEASURING OF HORSES

Measuring will be available on Wednesday by **PRIOR ARRANGEMENT ONLY**. There will be a charge of **\$10.00 (GST Inc.) per Horse. Foals \$5.00**. Contact Heather Lough if your horse requires measuring.

Please try and get your horses measured before this show - contact your NZMHA Regional Delegate for measuring information.

Please note the new Height Verification required for foals and yearlings.

HOLDING AREA

IMPORTANT: Horses will be called into the arena to be presented for judging in order of back numbers. To ensure the smooth running of the show Competitors must be in the collection area within 3 minutes of the last Competitor of the previous class entering the show ring. The gate steward will exclude late Competitors from competition in that class. This includes Champions and Supremes. Horses from the class immediately preceding are excluded from this requirement. The gate steward must be informed if a halter break is required, or the gate will not be held.

GENERAL

**BACK NUMBERS ARE TO BE WORN ON THE BACK
ENTER THE RING IN BACK NUMBER ORDER**

Once entered, no changes may be made to entries except under the following circumstances:

- horses entered as Category A and measured in excess of Height for Age for Category A prior to the judging of the first class on the first day of competition will be moved to the corresponding classes in Category B;
- where the horse entered for handler-related classes (best presented/showmanship/whip) is scratched from the Shows prior to the first class on the first day of competition another horse (already catalogued) may be substituted;
- horses/exhibitors entered in Novice classes who upgrade to Open prior to the Show will be moved to Open.
- Novice Handlers and Novice Horses - Cards are required to be lodged with Show Management prior to competition.

The organisers reserve the right to split/combine/cancel classes where entries warrant it

**All horses including foals must have a current NZMHA
Height Certificate in accordance with NZMHA Show Rules
NOTE: - Height Certificates must be NO OLDER THAN 45 days for Yearlings and Foals**

STABLING & PENS

Stables - \$25.00 per box per night

- For those staying 2 or more nights the cost is \$50.00 for the duration of the show.

Straw is provided for each box but you may order sawdust.

Note:

- Nominate Stable Requirements on Entry Form
- Please ensure you clean out stables/pens before departure;
- A **penalty of \$50.00** will be charged for each un-cleaned box;
- Please keep the stable area clean at all times by picking up all horse manure and rubbish after you.
- Please do not leave your horses tied up and left unattended in the stable aisles.

Should there be a conflict between this schedule and the NZMHA Show Rules or Constitution then this schedule shall not prevail. Please bring any such error or omission to the attention of the show organisers so that it can be rectified.

In accordance with Rule 24 of NZMHA's OFFICIAL RULE BOOK (CONSTITUTION AND RULES) and Rule G03.01 of NZMHA's OFFICIAL SHOW RULE BOOKLET 2011/2012 where a horse is leased, provided that notice of registration of the lease has been received at the office of the Registrar and all requirements thereof met at the time of entry to the show the lessee shall be treated as if they are the "Owner" of the horse for the purposes of these classes
